

## 50 Years Of Corvette Special Display



### Display requirements

- Stock appearance. Example: No mag-wheels, chrome aftermarket wheels, custom paint or exterior paint color from a different model year (i.e., black 1976 Corvette (black was not a factory offered color for CY 1976), aftermarket exhaust/mufflers, big-block hoods on small block cars, pin stripes, mud/splash guards, wings/aero packages, roll bars/racing harnesses, etc. Corvettes must have exterior and interior to factory stock appearance. Does not have to be car show certified/pedigree. Presentable drivers are welcome. If in doubt, please contact the NCM. "No For-Sale-Signs".
- Must have current vehicle registration and necessary car insurance effective.
- Vehicle has to be in good driving condition and meet all vehicle safety codes applicable to model year.

Note: 50 Corvette display will cover one Corvette from each production model years 1953 to 2003.

\$500 - per car registration/non-refundable. Credentials for two participants.

### Eligibility requirements

- NCM Membership required.
- Lottery system beginning with NCM Lifetime Members entries from December 1st to January 31st (drawing February 3rd). Must send total registration fee no later than February 28th.
  - Remaining display spots to be opened to general membership beginning March 1st to April 30th. Must send required registration fee no later than May 16th.
  - Proof of vehicle insurance and current vehicle registration required at time of event registration.

### Registrant Package

- One set of two (2) free Corvette 50th Anniversary adult event tickets
- One vehicle pass for parking on Coliseum grounds for one (1) alternate vehicle (since Corvette display vehicle will remain in position from approximately June 26 -

29, 2003)

- One support vehicle parking pass for any owners that trailer their display vehicle - trailer parking lot is near event grounds.
- One event-themed vehicle sign to support display - the owner may take it home at end of the event One set of two 50th Anniversary Logo pins from the collector set - to complete set of four or to use in Merchandise Trading Village
- Owner and display vehicle participation in the Friday, June 27, 2003 parade from Coliseum to downtown Nashville
- Possibility of having an event celebrity as passenger in display vehicle during parade
- Registration to National Corvette Caravan (NCM Event participation)
- Valid 30-day 50th Anniversary Kentucky vehicle license tag/registration
- Personalized commemorative plaque
- Display parking (NCM Front Circle)
- Limited edition 50 Years of Corvette participant merchandise

### **Corvette Parade**

The parade will begin Friday at 6:00 p.m. June 27, 2003. The routing will take it past the staging point for your vehicles. As the parade passes, a spot will open for each car to join the parade. The 50 Years of Corvette group will enter by decade starting with the 1953 and moving chronologically forward.

The cars will be staged for viewing in the 50 Years of Corvette area in the order that they will enter the parade so there will be no need to move the vehicle to position for parade entry.

We ask that all drivers be with their vehicles no later than 5:15 p.m. on June 27. A coordinator will be stationed at the 50 Years of Corvette viewing area to assist each group's entry into the parade line. Please listen to the parade coordinator and follow their instructions at that time.

The cars will enter the parade in a single line with a safe and appropriate distance between each vehicle. The parade speed will be between 3 to 5 miles per hour. Please do not push or crowd the people in front of you. Many of the other parade participants will be on foot in marching bands or other presentations and will not be able to move fast.

The parade route is approximately 2 miles. Plan on it taking an hour to complete the route. At the conclusion of the parade, we ask that you return your vehicle to the 50 Years of Corvette area on the event grounds for the night so that it is in place for Saturday's event.
